Dear San Carlos Condominium Owners,

As the Board of Directors, we are committed to ensuring the safety and protection of our community. In this regard, we have been working with Whitehaven Insurance to finalize our building insurance policy. We have received the final building insurance policy totaling \$1,491,252.34, which is significantly higher than last year's insurance premium.

As a result, the Board recently met and unanimously approved an Association assessment totaling \$900,000.00 to cover the increased cost of insurance. The breakdown of the assessment amount for each unit is as follows:
